This week in collective worship we have been taking part in anti-bullying week and thinking about how we need to show everyone kindness and respect.

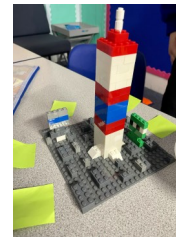
No Nuts Policy
